1	Plan a discussion with one or more key industry stakeholders to address the issue of home insurance, which remains a persistent issue. Action from the RTHC meeting: February 2021	<p>a) Action added to the RTHC Action Plan 2023–2025.</p> <p>b) It is even more relevant to define this topic and assess the options, as the issues are exacerbated by the forest fire situation, which has an impact on insurability (example experienced in Uashat).</p> <p>c) A CMHC research team looked into the issue of home insurance. This information has been added to the action plan. The research results will guide the RTHC's action planning in this area.</p> <p>d) By March 31, 2024, the RTHC-OC will assess the RBA (ISC), CNG and 2 FNs who self-insure files and follow up with the RTHC.</p> <p>June 2024 update:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The CMHC team has published a new “Research Insight” on home insurance in June 2024.• CMHC approved the Atlantic community of Membertou for self-insurance. A second Atlantic community has submitted an application, which is currently under review. These files open the door to exploring new applications.
2	Unifor’s commitment to First Nations housing. Action from the RTHC meeting: February 2023	<p>a) The construction trades mobile unit business plan was submitted to ISC by the FNAESC in July 2023, which funded its development.</p> <p>b) The business plan is currently being reviewed.</p> <p>June 2024 update:</p> <p>No new developments since November 2023 – A follow-up will be conducted with the RTHC-OC once the review is completed. the objective is to propose a recommendation to the coordinating members at a future RTHC meeting. Explore alternative options as needed if the timeframe for the mobile unit is too long (for example, mentoring, cash or other in-kind contributions, models of the training school site and circuit rider trainers).</p>
3	Survey conducted on the Indigenous Housing Connection newsletter and analysis of the results. Action from the RTHC meeting: February 2023	<p>a) The survey was administered at the CoPH meeting in May 2024</p> <p>June 2024 update:</p> <p>The survey responses will be analyzed by the RTHC-OC, which will also propose replacement solutions if necessary. This will allow a decision to be made on the future of the Indigenous Housing Connection. It appears that the current form is no longer an option.</p>
